The Quiet Waters park is home to Harbin Butterfly & Bird Sanctuary. South Florida is host to more than 300 species of birds and more than a hundred species of butterflies, making this sanctuary, named for a former director of Broward County Parks and Recreation Division, a welcome refuge.

- All volunteers should bring water. The park will have additional cold water available to refill reusable containers.
- Volunteers should read, sign, and bring the Waiver to the volunteer event.

**Directions from NSU Law:**

Start out going **north** on College Ave toward SW 30th St.

Turn **right** onto Nova Dr.

Take the 1st **left** onto Davie Rd.

**Merge** onto I-95 E

Take the **I-95 N** exit, EXIT 10A, toward **W Palm Beach/Ft Lauderdale**

Merge onto I-95 N.

Take the **FL-869/SW 10th St** exit,  
EXIT 41, toward **Sawgrass Expwy.**

Turn **left** onto SW 10th St/FL-869.

Turn **right** onto S Powerline Rd/FL-845.

Make a **U-turn** at SW 4th St onto S  
Powerline Rd/FL-845.

**End** at 401 S Powerline Rd, Deerfield  
Beach, FL 33442-8182 on the **right**.
