Elizabeth Pendo is the Joseph J. Simeone Professor of Law at Saint Louis University School of Law and a member of the Center for Health Law Studies and the William C. Wefel Center for Employment Law. Professor Pendo uses a disability justice framework to study the impact of health care and nondiscrimination laws on outcomes and experiences of people with disabilities in order to generate legal and policy solutions that promote health equity and social justice in our health care systems, workplaces, and communities. She has published law review articles, books, and other publications on issues in disability law and theory, health law and policy, and bioethics, and is one of the authors of a leading casebook, Health Law: Cases, Materials and Problems, 8th ed. (American Casebook Series, West).
