Take W State Road 84/FL-84 toward **W Palm Beach/Marina Mile Blvd.**

Merge onto I-95 N via the ramp on the **left**.

Merge onto W Atlantic Blvd/FL-814 via EXIT 36.

Turn **right** onto SE 18th Ave.

Take the 1st **left** onto SE 2nd St.

Take the 1st **right** onto SE 19th Ave.

**End** at 200 SE 19th Ave, Pompano Beach, FL 33060-7543 on the **left**.
