

Contracts and Transactional Law attorneys plan, draft, negotiate, and execute transactions between individuals, businesses, nonprofits, government agencies, and other types of organizations. They usually practice in one area of the law, like healthcare, financial services, technology, transportation, or manufacturing.

Transactional law in each of those practice areas requires the same skills: excellent reading and writing ability; negotiation skills; cultural competence; and a solid understanding of the fundamentals of contract law. Transactional lawyers must also understand the laws and regulations particular to their practice areas, e.g., data privacy in healthcare law.
