

Transportation and Railroad Law is an area of law that involves the legal issues affecting the transportation industry. Transportation and railroad law concerns the movement of passengers and cargo. The primary focus of the transportation industry is public safety. An attorney who works with clients in the transportation industry may handle a variety of matters, including matters related to insurance, licenses, oversight, personal injuries, employment, hazardous materials, piracy, security, and safety. Railroad law is a field within transportation law that involves the laws and regulations that apply to the railroad industry.
