

## **ACCESS LEX NSU LAW STUDENT EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND**

The College of Law, through a generous \$25,000 donation from the AccessLex Institute, is making available grants to students who have been adversely affected financially by the COVID-19 pandemic. We will be accepting grant applications through our scholarship app (instructions below), and awarding funds based on need for as long as we are able to do so.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Funds will be distributed to approved NSU students and are flexible to accommodate the wide and varied emergency needs of our students during this ever-evolving crisis. These emergency funds can be used for a wide variety of needs, *including but not limited to:*

- Technology (laptop, internet access, etc.) to optimize distance learning
- Rent and living expenses due to job loss or reduced hours
- Food insecurity
- Transportation from NSU for those whose permanent home is outside of the tricounty area.
- Medical bills
- Costs that may be incurred while studying for the Bar Examination

### **CRITERIA:**

Currently enrolled JD students at the NSU Shepard Broad College of Law must complete an application, via App Central, and demonstrate their need for emergency financial assistance during this pandemic. A faculty and administrative committee will review all applications. Approved students will receive emergency funds as determined by the amount of aid needed per applicant, and the one-time allocation of aid will be distributed as soon as funds are available. The criteria are:

- Submit a completed application explaining their emergency needs and purpose of funds
- Provide supporting documentation as needed
