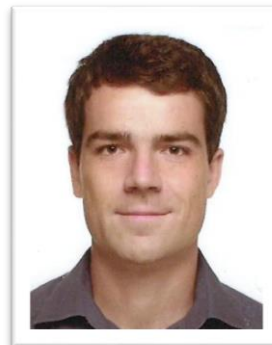
### Dual Degree Graduate Named Partner

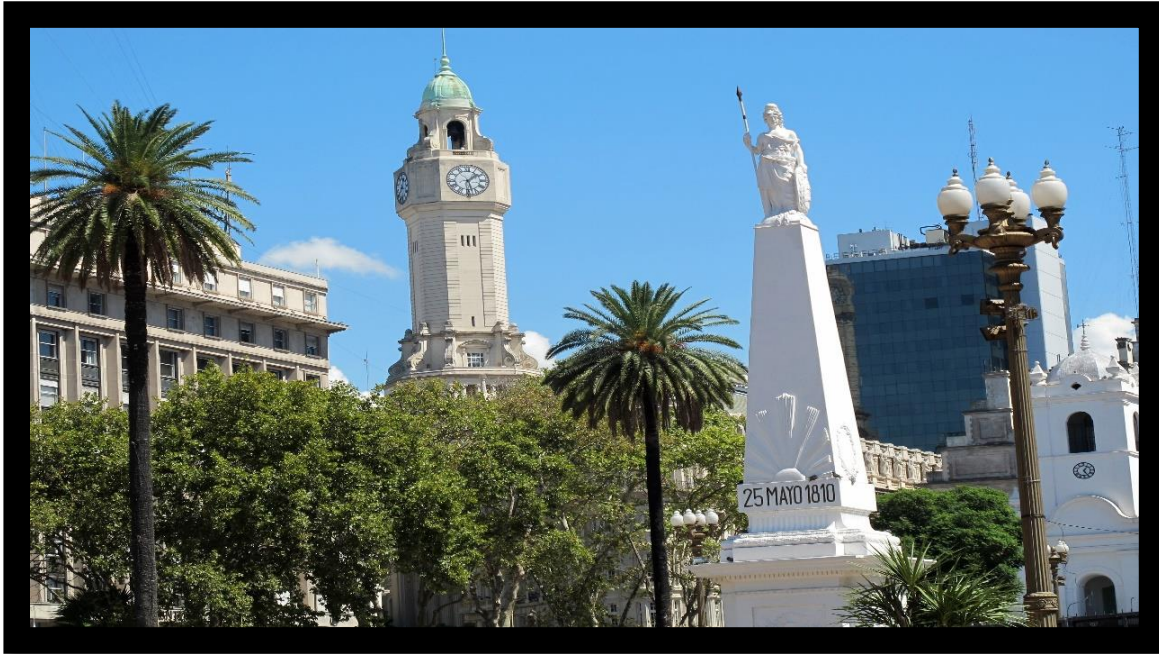


### Dual Degree Student Obtains Scholarship

### NSU Law Set to Direct a Summer Abroad Program in Buenos Aires

NSU Law will host a summer program in Buenos Aires from June 1, 2015 to June 26, 2015. Professor Jim Wilets will serve as the resident director of the program and teach a one-week course in International Trade Law. Two Argentine professors, Martin Bohmer and Ignacio Pérez Córtez, will teach Argentine Political Institutions and International Investment Litigation, respectively. Professor Sarah Gehwig-Moore from Mercer Law will teach Exploring Argentina's Legal Approach to Human Rights Abuse. Our first informational meeting regarding the Argentina program and programs in China, the Netherlands, and Spain, will take place on October 30, 2014.
