Program Costs

NSU students are charged [full day tuition and fees](#) during the Semester Abroad and Phase I semester. NSU students in Phase II of the Dual Degree will pay a reduced tuition for the length of Phase II. Refunds are consistent with NSU and NSU Law Policy (information available under [Student Policies](#)). Additional student fees may apply at both NSU and Roma Tre University.

Housing: \$800-\$1,500/month

Roundtrip Flight: \$1,400

Transportation: student's monthly pass to use public transportation: \$45

Miscellaneous: \$2,000/semester

Financial Aid

Financial aid is available for the semester abroad and dual degree programs. The estimated financial aid budget will take into consideration the different dates of attendance, cost of living, and airfare.
