

GPA CALCULATION

If you want a **Term GPA**:

1. Write the name of the course and grade received.
2. Write the grade equivalent for each.
 - A = 4.00
 - A- = 3.75
 - B+ = 3.50
 - B = 3.00
 - B- = 2.75
 - C+ = 2.50
 - C = 2.00
 - C- = 1.75
 - D+ = 1.50
 - D = 1.00
 - D- = 0.75
 - F = 0.00
3. Multiply the number of credits of each class by the grade number equivalent. This will give you quality points for each course.
4. Add the number of credits to achieve the GPA Hours.
5. Add the number of Quality Points.
6. Divide the number of Quality Points by the number of GPA Hours to receive a Term GPA.

If you want a **Cumulative GPA**, you must obtain the cumulative quality points from the University Information System. Follow the instructions below:

To obtain the quality points:

1. Access Webstar at <http://webstar.nova.edu> using your NSU ID # and your pin number
2. Click Student Services and Financial Aid
3. Click Student Records
4. Click Academic Transcript
5. Select Level and Type
6. Click Display Transcript

Once you have obtained the quality points, follow the instructions below:

1. Add the GPA Hours for all previous terms and the current GPA Hours
2. Add the Quality Points for all previous terms and the current Quality points.
3. Divide the Quality Points by the GPA Hours to receive a Cumulative GPA.
